1. Official facts first

- ☐ Open Rockstar's official GTA VI page and support pages.
- ☐ Confirm the supported platform, release information, edition, store region, and seller before paying.
- ☐ Do not treat leaks, retailer placeholders, or social posts as confirmed.
- ☐ Do not buy a PC around unannounced GTA VI PC requirements.

2. Account and purchase safety

- ☐ Confirm the correct console account and recovery email.
- ☐ Enable two-step verification and store recovery codes in a password manager.
- ☐ Review refund, preorder, tax, and delivery terms before purchase.
- ☐ Set a maximum launch budget including game, accessories, and subscription costs.

3. Console and storage

- ☐ Install current system software and restart the console.
- ☐ Check available storage without deleting irreplaceable captures or saves.
- ☐ Test the controller, charging cable, and spare battery plan.
- ☐ Leave ventilation space and clean dust only using manufacturer-safe instructions.

4. Display and audio

- ☐ Confirm the exact HDMI input and supported features in the display manual.
- ☐ Run the console's built-in video and HDR calibration.
- ☐ Test headset or speaker compatibility, comfort, microphone, and chat balance.
- ☐ Review subtitle size, color, motion, and other accessibility options.

5. Network and launch day

- ☐ Run a wired and wireless connection test where the console will be used.
- ☐ Update the router only with vendor-supported firmware and keep credentials private.
- ☐ Avoid unofficial downloads, account sellers, currency sellers, cheats, and launch-day scams.
- ☐ Plan breaks, hydration, household bandwidth, and a reasonable play schedule.
